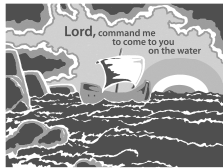

*From the Pastor. . . **Introduction!*** Last week, I wanted to write an introduction but was simply too busy to do so, so here goes! I am originally from Pittsburgh. I grew up within city limits in a neighborhood called Crafton Heights. (Crafton Heights is adjacent to Greentree and Crafton.) I am the oldest of four and yes my parents are still living. (I just had dinner with them this past Monday and they are doing quite well. In fact, they are quite happy [as am I] that I am now so close to them.) Being from Pittsburgh makes me a die hard Steelers fan. 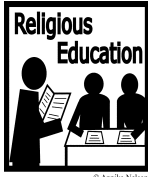

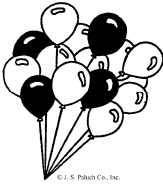
